Items For Bowel Prep:

- 1) CLENPIQ PREP- TWO WEEKS PRIOR to procedure, please call SUSIE 352-364-9060
- 2) 4 DULCOLAX (Bisacodyl 10mg) tablets (*Available over-the-counter*)
- 3) 2 EXTRA STRENGTH GAS-X tablets (*Available over-the-counter*)

Hold the following medication(s): _____ starting _____

Hold GLP-1 Agonists: Semaglutide (Ozempic/Wegovy/Rybelsus), Dulaglutide (Trulicity), Liraglutide (Victoza/Saxenda), Tirzepatide (Mounjaro/Zepbound)

- If oral **daily**: Hold medication for **2 days prior** to the procedure date.
- If injectable **weekly**: Hold medication for **1 week prior** to the procedure date.

ONE DAY PRIOR TO YOUR PROCEDURE:

- DO NOT EAT SOLID FOOD; Clear liquid diet ONLY ALL DAY
- HYDRATION IS PART OF YOUR PREP! DRINK LOTS OF FLUIDS.
- It's OK to have juice, broth, tea, coffee, Jello, Gatorade/Powerade, and popsicles.
 - NOTHING RED OR PURPLE, NO DAIRY PRODUCTS and NO ALCOHOL.
- Drink 8oz of clear liquids every 90 minutes.
- **AT 10:00 am** take 2 Dulcolax tablets
- **AT 6:00pm** drink your first bottle of Clenpiq (do not sip, drink it all down)
 - Between 6-9 pm, drink FIVE 8oz glasses of clear fluids.
- **AT 8:00 pm** take 2 GAS-X tablets
- **AT 10:00 pm** take 2 Dulcolax tablets
- Ok to continue clear liquids for the rest of the day.

DAY OF YOUR PROCEDURE:

- **AT 6:00am** drink your second bottle of Clenpiq (again do not sip, drink it all down)
 - Between 6-8 am. Drink FOUR 8oz glasses of clear liquids.
- Do not drink anything after _____ AM.
- Take your heart, blood pressure, and seizure medication ONLY with a small sip of water.
- Take half (1/2) dose of your usual insulin
- Bring your I.D. and method of payment.
- Leave all personal items at home. Wear warm socks. We are NOT responsible for lost items.
- Arrange for a driver to take you home!

*Anesthesia is billed separately (billed through your insurance first)

*Pathology charges are generated after procedure (billed through your insurance first)
